

Heber Valley Gun Club
Board of Directors Meeting

April 25, 2020

Attendees: Vince McCauley, Pam McCauley, Corey Hardman, George Martin, Jon McKeon, Randy Thomson, Al Davis, Josh Garmon. Absent, Karl Buchanan

Meeting called to order at 9:05 AM

1. The financial reports were distributed and reviewed by George Martin. Jon noted that we have received two grants for \$2500 each and a new revenue category for them will be added in April. The financial reports will be posted on the website along with the meeting minutes.
2. Jon also discussed that he will be submitting grant requests to the Utah DWR, the ATA and to the NRA in the near future.
3. We received a proposal from a local contractor to supply and install new railing in the clubhouse for the stairs and the balcony. This expenditure was approved unanimously by the board.
4. Josh Garmon indicated that he would like the club to host a two-day charity event for the Young Life organization. It was agreed that the event would be held on June 27 and 28.
5. Corey reviewed the construction improvement projects that have been recently completed including: 1 concrete dock at the connex as well is an overhead door to more easily accommodate unloading the storage of targets, New concrete in front and on the west side of the clubhouse and addition of gutters and downspouts to better manage runoff from the clubhouse.
6. Corey also indicated that they are proceeding to construct a berm on the north end of the property north of the sporting clays course to better isolate shooters and noise from the adjacent neighbors. This project will be ongoing through the summer months.
7. Discussed the upcoming Browning sporting clays shoot which we believe will be able to occur. We will finalize the decision and logistics development for the shoot by mid-May. The shoot is planned for May 29, 30 & 31.
8. Corey announced that the club will host the Utah State Sporting Clays tournament to be held on Aug. 13 to 16. There is significant planning completed and more to be completed through the next three months.
9. After much discussion of details it was decided that we will open the club for member and public shooting beginning May 2 if allowed by Wasatch County.
10. Vince emphasized that we must restrict the personnel in the trap and skeet houses to board members until the Covid 19 threats are reduced. Also remember to spray disinfectant in the houses when closing.
11. Randy discussed the planned ATA trap shoot scheduled for July 11 and 12. We will not plan to provide food for that shoot this year and additional planning is ongoing to support the event.
12. Meeting adjourned at 10:40 AM.
