

COVID-19 OPERATING PROCEDURES

In accordance with the Heber City Municipal Covid-19 Recommendations:

1. If you are sick, or not feeling well, please stay home, or go home, until you are well.
2. Please maintain all "Social Distancing" recommendations, and do not group together. The Club House has been cleaned and sterilized, as well as the Trap and Skeet houses.
3. Clubhouse access will be limited, and only for essential needs. Also, please do not enter ANY of the Trap and Skeet houses for any reason. If there is a problem, please find a Volunteer to fix the problem.
4. Please leave all weapons in your vehicles, or outside on the tables and stands. There will be extra stands available for your use.
5. Sign-in will now be at the outside office window, under the porch. A Volunteer will take your name and sign you in. You MUST sign in before shooting, as we must be able to control the number of people on site.
6. We will handle any squadding issues that arise. If there is a wait, we will assign you a time to shoot.
7. Only one squad will be allowed on the field at a time. You will be welcome to stay well back or in your vehicle until it is your turn to shoot.
8. Any decision rendered by a Board Member is to be viewed as mandatory. This is due, in part, to the ever changing conditions.
9. Enjoy your shooting, and help us keep everyone safe.

Since everyone has been looking for something to do in the wake of all the closures, we are attempting to stay open and safe for everyone to enjoy shooting. Please help us in this endeavor. Also, keep in mind that these restrictions may be changed at any time based on government restrictions.
